



## FSS PLAN - BENEFITS



<b>Territoriality</b>	All necessary treatments are covered in Switzerland like the benefits list of the Swiss health insurance Law KVG-LAMal and abroad, in case of emergency, up to the double of the Swiss tariffs (residence canton)
<b>In-patient treatments</b>	Hospitalisation in a public or university hospital General ward in the whole Switzerland included free in the plan
<b>Out-patient treatments</b>	General practitioners, specialists
<b>Medicine</b>	Prescript medicine like "List of pharmaceutical specialities"
<b>Preventive healthcare</b>	The cost of various procedures and examinations designed to protect your health (preventive healthcare).
<b>Complementary medicine</b>	Acupuncture, anthroposophical medicine, traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) pharmacotherapy, medical classical homoeopathy, phytotherapy, interference zone therapy (neural therapy according to Huneke).
<b>Maternity</b>	Pregnancy: the cost of seven routine antenatal examinations carried out by a doctor or a midwife and two ultrasound examinations (one between the 11th and 14th weeks of pregnancy and one between the 20th and 23rd weeks). In high-risk pregnancies your insurance will cover as many examinations and ultrasound examinations as necessary. CHF 100 towards the cost of group antenatal classes held by midwives. Birth of your baby, as long as it is attended by a doctor or a midwife in a hospital, at home or at a birthing centre. After the birth, one post-natal examination between the 6th and 10th weeks after the baby is born, and up to three breast feeding advice sessions provided by midwives or specially trained nursing staff.
<b>Hospital care for new born</b>	The hospital and nursing costs incurred for a healthy newborn baby while its mother is still in hospital are part of the mother's maternity benefits, i.e. they are covered by the mother's health insurance (there is no cost-sharing). However, if the baby is or becomes ill, the associated costs are covered by the baby's insurance (with cost-sharing).
<b>Physiotherapy</b>	Prescript by a doctor, 9 session
<b>Medical aids and devices</b>	Prescript by a doctor and like the list of the Migel / Lima
<b>Dental treatments</b>	80% only for serious mouth or jaw disorder... The insurance does not cover the cost of conventional fillings in decayed teeth or the correction of misaligned teeth.
<b>Spa treatments</b>	CHF 10 per day (for up to 21 days per year) if the spa treatment is prescribed by a doctor and in a recognized center
<b>Nursing care at home</b>	Like the definition mentioned in the Swiss health insurance law
<b>Accidental capital</b>	CHF 10.000 in case of a death following an accident
<b>Repatriation</b>	Medical evacuation to the residential country
<b>Transport &amp; rescue</b>	CHF 500 for transport & CHF 5000 for rescue
